

Monthly Report –February 14, 2017, Town of Oswego Highway Department

- Rathburn Road bridge. Hydraulic flow tests and soil samples are on hold due to weather conditions. Probable window for work will probably be July 15 – Aug 30 due to Class C Trout Stream classification. This will also impact County replacement of bridge on Co Rt 20, upstream of our project.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Waiting for spring
- Plowing season is underway. Reminder to all, there is NO PARKING on Town roads from November 15 – April 15.
- Snowplow Grant has been submitted. Still waiting for Rural Development to receive cash. Uncertain as to when/if money will be distributed.
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- BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS
- Air compressor @ Town Hall needs a new switch – has been replaced. System still has air leak issues, compressor runs more often than it should per Davis Ulmer Technician. We need to verify continued inspections through local inspection company as in the past.
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- SEWER SYSTEMS
- Ontario Heights – New heater in controls room has been overloading the circuit breaker. Problem solved through recircuiting.
- Sleepy Hollow – issues with the pump at the end of the system – not working automatically as necessary. Needed new float and PVC pipe repair. Repaired by T. Flett/Camden Group. At considerable savings.
- Sleepy Hollow household seeking reimbursement for a bill to scope sewer line, leading to major repair at main, 2015. Homeowner had several repairs made to lateral, WD Malone repaired issue at main. I have notified homeowner that invoices from time of service and proof of payment be submitted before claim can be reviewed for payment.
