

Monthly Report –March 14, 2017, Town of Oswego Highway Department

- Rathburn Road bridge. Hydraulic flow tests are on hold due to weather conditions. Soil samples complete. Probable window for work will probably be July 15 – Aug 30 due to Class C Trout Stream classification. This will also impact County replacement of bridge on Co Rt 20, upstream of our project. Had a meeting today w/ BCA, still working towards a single path to replacement.
- NYSDOT, State Route 104 project. Contractor is on site, surveying. This week, will be installing new temp. signaling devices at Sivers/Vet Clinic site. March 27, Snake creek will again be 1 lane. April 3rd, expect to be full crew. National Grid (Todd Cable Construction and Deketherm, 2 sub-contractors), to begin replacing gas line from New St. to Fred Haynes Blvd. Also, from Jackim rd. to top of Perry hill. All weather permitting.
- Plowing season is underway. Reminder to all, there is NO PARKING on Town roads from November 15 – April 15.
- Snowplow Grant has been submitted. Still waiting for Rural Development to receive cash. Distribution scheduled for April 23. Looking at a 15 year repayment @ 3.375%
- Wednesday, March 8, in Albany for Advocacy Day. Spoke with Senator Ritchie and Assemblyman Oaks concerning the Rathburn/Thompson Rd bridges. Will look for funds this month as budgets are prepared. Also, spoke with Sen Ritchie about the grant for the comm. center.
